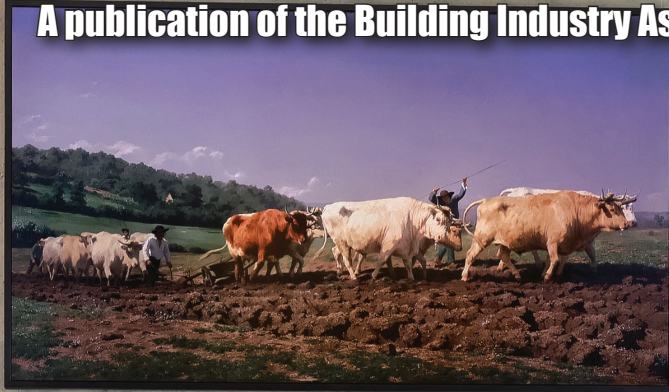

EGStoltzfus Custom Homes & Remodeling and Keystone Custom Homes Take Top Parade Honors

The two most coveted local honors in home building were recently announced, recognizing all Parade of Homes entries and the winning homes. Sponsored by **Fulton Bank** and **UGI Utilities** and presented by the **Building Industry Association of Lancaster County** (BIA), the Lancaster/Lebanon Parade of Homes opened the area's best new homes for touring both in-person and virtually. This year's Parade featured 21 single-family homes, duplexes and remodeling projects from 12 different builders, ranging in price from \$441,990 to over \$1,000,000.

The **2025 Parade of Homes Fulton Bank Award for Best Single Family Home** was bestowed on **EGStoltzfus Custom Homes & Remodeling** (Entry #13). This beautiful 4,066 sq. ft. Tudor style home features 4 bedrooms, 4 and 2 half baths, a 3-car garage, as well as the following:



- A combination of real stone, painted brick and Hardi-Plank exterior
- 10' first-floor ceiling, 9' second-floor ceilings
- Large custom kitchen with combination of painted and rift sawn white oak cabinets
- Scullery with hidden access through main kitchen cabinet door
- His and Her offices
- First-floor owner's suite with wet room, his and her closets, and hidden access from owner's bathroom to laundry space
- Finished basement with wellness room, bar, media area, and hidden speakeasy
- Custom dog wash station in family entry
- Two-story fireplace with faux concrete finish
- Large covered patio in rear with gas fireplace



The **2025 Parade of Homes Fulton Bank Award for Best Duplex** was presented to **Keystone Custom Homes** for their entry at 1239 Hershey Lane, Lancaster (Entry #19). The three-bedroom, 2 ½ bath home offers:

- Open-concept main living area with kitchen, family room and dining area
- Cathedral ceiling with beadboard detail in the main living area
- Kitchen boasts quartz countertops and backsplash, two-toned cabinets, and an eat-in island
- Family room features a white brick veneer gas fireplace
- Private Study with white brick veneer accent wall
- 1 st-floor owner's suite with floor-to-ceiling Kingston wainscoting
- Owner's suite bath boasts a dual vanity, tiled shower, and walk in closet
- 1 st-floor laundry room with vertical shiplap and workstation
- Study nook on the second floor
- Partially finished basement with café

The **2025 Parade of Homes Honorable Mentions** for the Fulton Bank Awards went to **Pine Hill Building Co.** for their single-family entry at 837 Wheatfield Lane, Lebanon (Entry #9), and **Landmark Homes** for their duplex entry at 504 Stonegate Blvd., Annville (Entry #16).

The Parade entries were separated into 9 divisions according to the price and type (single-family home, duplex and remodeling project). Along with the Fulton Bank Awards, one home in each division earned a "Best of Show" Award, with additional awards for "Best" in: Exterior, Interior Design, Kitchen, Bath and Decorated. The entries were judged on June 10th & 11th by industry professionals from outside the area, using a numerical scoring system.

PA Uniform Construction Code (UCC) Enforcement Update on the Changes to the PA UCC:

Enforcement Date Pushed Back

We want to inform you of a key update regarding the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code (UCC) and the adoption of the 2021 International Code Council (ICC) Model Codes.

The PA Department of Labor and Industry has not completed the regulatory process required to enforce the 2021 ICC codes. As a result, the previously anticipated enforcement date of **July 13, 2025**, is no longer valid. We will immediately notify you when we have a new enforcement date.

Based on the required steps still necessary and in combination with publicized meeting dates and statutory timelines, the Department and municipal officials will not be able to enforce the 2021 changes to the UCC until these legal requirements are met.

What this means:

- Based on the required actions still necessary, the Department

will not be able to enforce the 2021 UCC updates.

- The official enforceable date will be announced once the Department submits the regulatory language to the appropriate state agencies for review and approval.

Why this matters:

- The official enforceable date determines which version of the PA UCC applies to a construction project.

Key guidance:

- If a **design or construction contract is signed before the new enforceable date**, it may follow the 2018 PA UCC, provided the building permit is applied for within **six months** of the new enforceable date.
- If a **design or construction contract is signed after the enforceable date** or if the permit is not applied for within that six-month window, the project must comply with the **2021 PA UCC**.

We will share the confirmed enforceable date as soon as it becomes available.

Statutory Reference:

Act 45 of 1999 – PA Uniform Construction Code

Section 304. Revised or successor codes

Subsection (c)(4) - Where a design **or** construction contract was **signed before the effective date of regulations** for a subsequent Uniform Construction Code or International Fuel Gas Code issued under this act, the permit may be issued **under the Uniform Construction Code** or International Fuel Gas Code **in effect at the time the design or construction contract was signed if the permit is applied for within six months of the effective date of the regulation** or the period specified by a municipal ordinance, whichever is less.
